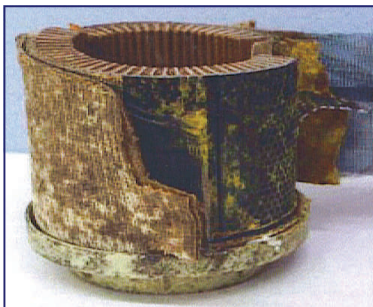

## Cost Associated with Untreated Microbial Growth

### **Damaged vehicles**

- Towing charges
- Fuel Injectors Replacement
- Fuel Tank cleaning or replacement

### **Additional Truck maintenance**

- Frequent Filter Changing

### **Additional Maintenance Fueling System**

- Labor and Filter replacement

### How Can YOU Detect Microbial Growth

- Water is found in the tank because of either water paste on stick or by visual inspection of proper bottom samples.
- Inventory probe has slime film on it
- Noticeable reduction in flow rate, below 7 gallons per minute
- Changing filters at a location more than 2 times per year

## We have the answer and treatment for your diesel tanks.

Five years ago, we introduced our **Preventative Maintenance / Compliance Program**. Our customers no longer dread the OSFM's inspections. However, their new concern is with the issue of microbial growth in their diesel tanks. At their request we have tested and proven a program which will treat your diesel tank and reduce your maintenance needs.

With our program we:

1. Check your strainer and filters for signs of bacterial growth
2. Clean strainer and change your filters if required
3. Determine if bacterial growth is present



If growth is not present, we then check for water and pump any water as a preventative measure. Program price includes 1 D.O.T. approved drum. The drum will be left on site for disposal by owner. We will troubleshoot to find the entry point and give recommendations for corrective action.

If treatment is required, we will add the fuel treatment to your tank.

In **six months we will come back** out to:

1. Test your tank for water in the fuel.
2. Clean your strainer
3. Change your filters
4. Retreat your tank
